To desiccate your soybeans, you may follow this recommendation:

Glyphosate (0.67L/ac of 540 g/l concentration) + Aim (48mL/acre) PHI= 7 days Glyphosate (0.67L/ac of 540 g/l concentration) + Eragon LQ (30ml/ac) + Merge (0.4L/ac) PHI= 7 days Eragon LQ (59ml/ac) + Merge (0.4L/ac) PHI= 2 days
